Direction to Staff

by the Planning and Zoning Board at the January Meeting

Crabtree Crossing Parkway Extension

- PZB given four Options at January meeting
 - Option 1: Bring back additional information
 - Option 2: Change to greenway
 - Option 3: Keep as road with modifications
 - Option 4: Remove
- PZB selected Option 3:
 - Keep the proposed road extension in the draft Plan, with modifications. Recommended modifications:
 - Require further study once NC 147 construction is complete (cannot construct until NC 147 built)
 - Reinforce prioritization of roadway projects
 - Review potential ways to legally limit cut-through traffic and messaging on traffic congestion navigation mobile applications, such as Waze

- Review of the revised draft Plan
 - Begins in March
 - Lasts approximately 3-4 months
- Presentation of draft Plan by staff
 - Begins in March
 - Lasts approximately 1-2 months
- Open a Public Comment Session on the revised draft
 - Multi-month public comment period recommended by staff
 - Start date set by the Planning and Zoning Board
- Planning and Zoning Board will forward a recommendation on the draft Comprehensive Transportation Plan Update to Town Council
 - Occurs after the Public Comment Session is closed

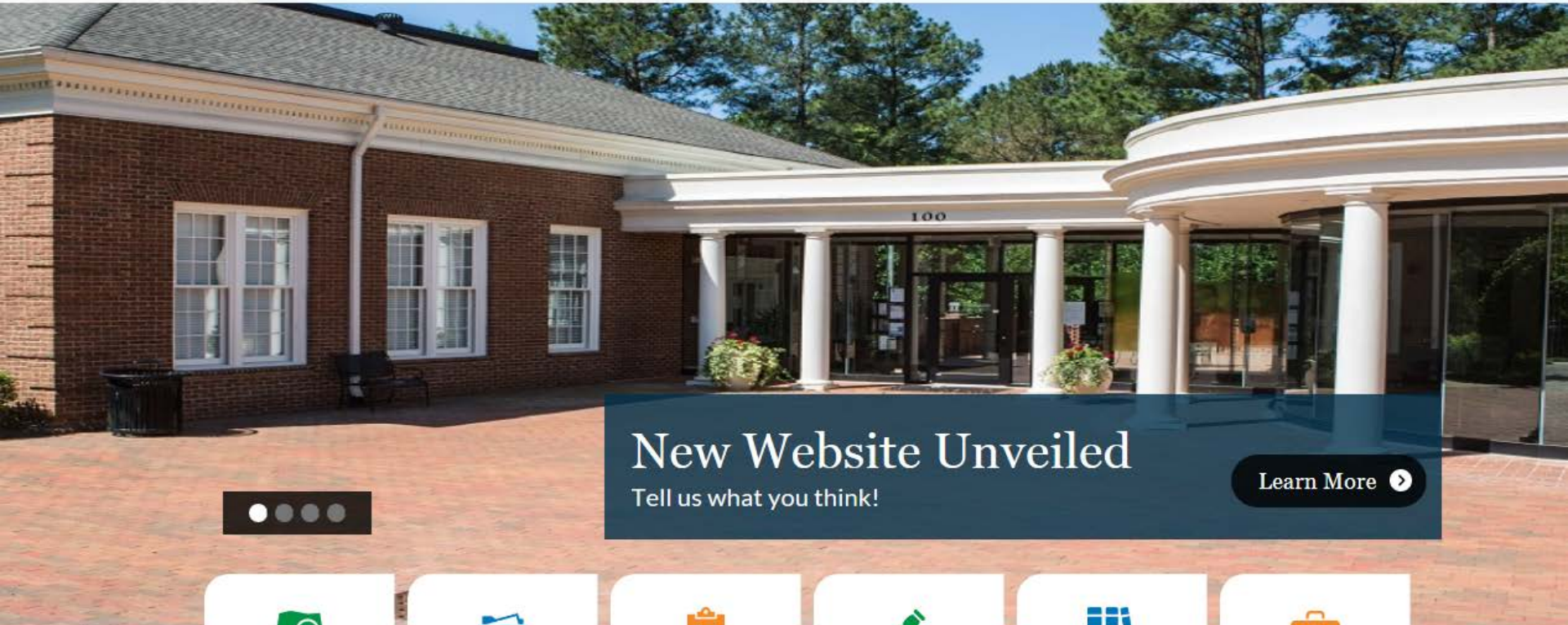
