Below are additional changes to the Draft Comprehensive Transportation Plan Update, February 23, 2018 Version (recommended by Staff, the Planning and Zoning Board and Town Council) that are reflected in the June 6, 2018 Version of the Draft Comprehensive Transportation Plan Update. Some of the Staff Recommended Modifications were previous directives by the Planning & Zoning Board during their review of the September 25, 2017 Draft Comprehensive Transportation Plan Update. Each change is identified as staff (S), public comment (PC), Planning and Zoning Board (PZB), and/or Town Council (TC) initiated change. Hyperlinks are also provided to the Chapter and/or section where the recommended modification(s) will take place.

General

- Added hyperlinks to the <u>Table of Contents</u> (S)
- Added <u>Table of Contents</u> title (Page 3 of the PDF) and <u>List of Figures</u> title (Page 4 of the PDF) (S)
- Added Town Hall Drive Extension impacts multiple chapters (S)
 - No connection to NC 147
 - Design consistent with direction provided by RTP at March 7th meeting
 - Town Hall Drive extension would provide secondary access to neighborhoods along Church Street between McCrimmon Parkway and NC 540 that currently only have access to one collector street (Church Street)
- Hyperlinked the terms in the text of the document that are defined in Appendix A (PZB)
 - Specific terms cannot be linked to a definition in the glossary
 - A hyperlink to the Glossarv can be added.

Chapter 3

- Revised <u>Figure 3-3</u> to reflect that the recommended alignment of NC 147 in the Draft CTP does not match the preferred NCDOT alignment for the project funded in the STIP (PZB)
- Clarified that the widening on I-40 consists of adding auxiliary lanes and managed lanes under Other Relevant Committed Roadway Projects on Page 3-2 (PC)
- Updated <u>Table 3-1</u> to include the I-5700 Airport Boulevard/I-40 Interchange Project (PC)
- Specified that the proposed Morrisville-Carpenter Road Grade Separation is located at the intersection of Morrisville-Carpenter Road, railroad tracks, NC 54 and Aviation Parkway in Table 3-5 (PC)

- Updated the Crabtree Crossing Parkway Extension label in <u>Figure 5-3</u> and showed the Crabtree Hatcher Creek Greenway connections to Crabtree Crossing Parkway and Morrisville-Carpenter Road as existing greenways (S)*
- Labeled greenways and moved location of sidepath on Airport Boulevard in <u>Figure 5-3</u>
 (S)
- Modified Prioritized Roadway Improvements <u>Table 5-8</u> as follows (S/PZB)
 - Changed to Short-Term
 - Davis Dr./McCrimmon Pkwy.
 - Airport Blvd. Grade Separation
 - Crabtree Crossing Pkwy./Morrisville Pkwy.
 - Slater Rd./Carrington Mill Blvd.
 - Changed to Mid-Term
 - NC 54/Morrisville Pkwy.
 - NC 54/Cary Pkwy.
 - Changed to Long-Term
 - Morrisville-Carpenter Rd. Grade Separation
 - Added to Short-Term
 - NC54 and Keybridge Drive Intersection*
