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# Planning & Zoning Board Questions and Comments

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- **Question 1:** Once Parkside Elementary is built, what streets will be used to get into and out of the school grounds?
  - **Answer 1:**
    - Carpool traffic will enter school site via new driveway on Parkside Valley Drive, located between Willingham Road and Mannington Drive
    - Carpool Traffic will exit school site via new driveway on Little Drive
    - Bus, Staff and Visitors will enter and exit school site via new driveway on Little Drive



# Planning & Zoning Board Questions and Comments

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- **Question 2:** I have heard that there will not be enough parking at the school when finished and people will have to park on adjacent residential streets. Do you know if this is true?
  - **Answer 2:** The school site has been designed based on NCDOT standards to allow adequate storage so that all carpool traffic will remain on site and off public roads.



# Planning & Zoning Board Questions and Comments

- **Question 3:** Table 3-2, Street Design Guide – Town Hall Drive has two street classifications (Minor Thoroughfare and Collector). Should the entirety of Town Hall Drive be classified as a Collector?
  - **Answer 3:** Town Hall Drive Classifications
    - McCrimmon Parkway to Morrisville-Carpenter Road: 4-lane, median-divided facility connecting two Major Thoroughfares
    - North of McCrimmon Parkway: undivided road connecting neighborhoods to Thoroughfares



# Planning & Zoning Board Questions and Comments

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- **Question 4:** Clarification of Cross-Section and Speed Limits for Town Hall Drive
  - **Answer 4:** Town Hall Drive Cross-Section and Speeds
    - Modified 4A Cross-Section - narrow lanes and a narrow median
    - Speed Limits in Table 3-2 are guidelines and maximums



# Planning & Zoning Board Questions and Comments

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- **Question 5:** Definitions of Near-, Mid- and Long-Term for Tables 5-6 and 5-8?
  - **Answer 5:** Terms defined on Page 5-3, and applicable to Tables 5-6 and 5-8:
    - Near-term: Less than 15 years
    - Mid-term: 15-24 years
    - Long-term: 25 or more years
