THE FOLLOWING MANUAL HAS BEEN PREPARED TO ACQUAINT YOU WITH SOME GENERAL RULES AND CONCERNS REGARDING OUR VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM. PLEASE KEEP THIS WITH YOU SO THAT YOU MAY REFER TO IT AS NEEDED.

We feel we have good coaches in our Girls Youth Volleyball program. However, if at any time you have a problem with a coach(s) that cannot be worked out amongst yourselves, please bring these problems to the Athletic Staff's attention.

**Registration Dates & Fees for 2019 Fall Volleyball:**

June 3<sup>rd</sup> for Residents of Morrisville; Cost is \$50/participant

June 17<sup>th</sup> for Non-Residents of Morrisville; Cost is \$75/participant

**\*\*Registration is taken only as long as space allows. Waiting Lists will be taken once leagues have begun to fill.\*\***

**LEAGUES OFFERED (NOTE: Ages are based upon child's age as of October 31, 2019):**

Minor Volleyball: 7-9 year old girls

Major Volleyball: 10-12 year old girls

**PLACEMENT DATE (Majors only):**

**Major Volleyball Tryouts - Thursday, August 1<sup>st</sup>; Cedar Fork Community Center at 6:30pm.**

All participants will need to try-out, unless they are the child of a volunteer Coach or Assistant Coach or if they played on a team in the Majors League last Fall (2017). In addition, an e-mail notification will be sent to those who need to attend placements.

**PRACTICES:**

Practice dates and times will be assigned prior to the season beginning and handed out to coaches at the preseason Head Coaches meetings. Each team will have 2-3 team events per week, whether it be 2 practices/week; 1 practice/week and 1 game/week; or 2 games/week. Practice days during the week will vary week-to-week Monday through Friday evenings and one practice/game on Saturdays. Games will be played on weekends (primarily Minors VB) and weeknights as well (Majors VB will split in order to accommodate the necessary number of games).

**NOTE:** This schedule may vary as changes warrant, i.e. number of teams per league, rain-outs, make-up games, etc.

**NOTE:** Each player is expected to be at all dept. scheduled practices and games. If player cannot attend, it is their duty to notify the coach. Missing practice may result in disciplinary action, i.e. loss of playing time during games. Parents are responsible for keeping the coach informed.

**REGULAR SEASON GAMES/TOURNAMENT:**

Practice for Minors and Majors Volleyball leagues are scheduled to begin the week of August 6<sup>th</sup> and games are scheduled to begin September 10<sup>th</sup>. All Minors and Majors games and practices will be held at Cedar Fork Community Center.

**NOTE:** The Major Volleyball league will have a single elimination tournament at the end of the regular season.

### **EQUIPMENT/ UNIFORMS:**

Each player will receive a game jersey which she will keep after the season is over. Cold weather clothes will be allowed as needed, but game jerseys must be worn **over** them for the benefit of the officials and other players on the court.

**NOTE:** No names are to be screened or ironed on the jersey fronts or backs for any reason.

**NOTE:** No jerseys are to be cut or altered in any way. If this is done the player will be required to replace that uniform at his/her own expense. The player will NOT be allowed to play in any matches until an unaltered uniform is worn to a game.

### **PARKING:**

For practices/games scheduled at Cedar Fork Community Center (CFCC), parking is available in front of the CFCC building.

### **WEATHER HOTLINE # (919)463-6215:**

For your convenience we will have a weather hotline available to you. When you call the weather hotline #, you will hear a recording informing you if practices and/or games have been cancelled or not. This line will be available by 4:00pm on weekdays and before 7am on weekends. Unfortunately, there are times when we cannot make decisions right up until game time, however, the main objective is always safety. Decisions to cancel scheduled practices and/or games will be based upon weather and/or the chance of severe inclement weather.

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### **What do my fees pay for?**

The fees that are acquired through registration are used for a number of different things. It buys volleyball equipment such as nets, volleyballs, etc. Each child is also provided with a game jersey for the volleyball season. Fees are also used to administer background checks for our volleyball head coaches. We also pay for the costs of the National Youth Sports Coach's Association certification for all of our volunteer head coaches. It also helps us fund our game officials/umpires as well as all of our MPRCR staff members.

#### **Where can I register my child?**

Participants can be registered in person at the Parks & Rec. Administration Building or Cedar Fork Community Center. Registration forms may be filled out prior to your arrival at either center and are available on our website at <http://www.townofmorrisville.org>. The Town of Morrisville Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Resources Department is proud to offer on-line registration to help facilitate your program registration. If you have participated with any of our programs before, please call the main office at 463-7110 to have your User Name and Password emailed to you. If you have not participated in our programs before, please visit <https://webtrac.townofmorrisville.org> to fill out the requested information to receive a User Name and Password. All User Names and Passwords will be sent to you within 48 hours.

#### **How are players assigned to teams?**

Players will return to their team from the Fall 2018 season if they remain in the same age group, unless a written request is received 2 weeks prior to start of season **and** is approved by MPRCR Athletics staff. In these cases, the child will then go back into the league computerized random selection. Players who are moving to a new age group or are new to the program will be automatically drafted at random using a computerized system. The Majors League will have placements for all players who are new to the league. Players who register late will not be guaranteed to play on the same team as the previous season. Once a player has been selected to a team she will remain on that team throughout the age eligibility for that league, unless a written request is received 2 weeks prior to start of season and is approved by MPRCR athletics staff. In these cases, the child will then go back into the league draft. **NO PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO CHANGE TEAMS DURING THE SEASON.** If a child registers late or is taken off of the waiting list, they will be placed on the first available team, no money or registration forms are accepted until a spot is open. The coaches will not be able to select players from the list. **NOTE:** Special requests (carpooling, classmates, etc.) will not be honored at any league level.

### **What is the NYSCA program?**

The National Alliance for Youth Sports is a non-profit organization based in West Palm Beach, Florida, founded in 1981 as the National Youth Sport Coaches Association (NYSCA) with the mission of improving out-of-school sports for the more than 20 million youth participants under the age of 16. The Alliance believes (1) participation in youth sports develop important character traits and values, and (2) the lives of youths can be positively impacted if the adults caring for them have proper training and information. We require our head coaches to go through this certification process before they may coach a team. This training program paid for by MPRCR provides coaches with information and skills that positively affect the children in their care.

### **Why doesn't Morrisville offer a Volleyball league for teens?**

The majority of the youth we serve in Morrisville are ages 12 & under. As the children age up we intend to add Junior leagues (Ages 13+) as funding allows in the recreation budget. Our goal is to eventually be able to offer Junior leagues for all our youth sports that are offered in Morrisville!

### **What is your refund/cancellation policy?**

#### **ALL REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS MUST BE IN WRITING ON THE CANCELLATION/REFUND/TRANSFER REQUEST FORM.**

A full refund is given if the Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources Department cancels a program, facility rental or athletics league. Refunds are not given for individual class or game cancellations due to weather or circumstances beyond the control of the Department. Makeup sessions/games are scheduled whenever possible. For youth athletics registrations, a full refund minus a \$5.00 administrative fee will be considered if written request is received prior to the following: Spring leagues – March 1; Fall leagues – August 1; Winter leagues – November 1. For youth athletics refund requests received after these dates, a 50% refund will be considered only if the enrollment can be filled from a waiting list. No refunds are considered after completion of programs, facility rentals or athletic leagues. Medical hardship cases will be handled at the discretion of the Director of Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources. Medical documentation may be required during review of the refund request.
