Morrisville Environment & Stormwater Poster Contest Rules

We invite all of Morrisville's public and private school children and youth organizations to showcase their artistic talent and their commitment to the environment by participating in the 14th Annual Morrisville Recycles Week Poster Contest. This poster contest will help us achieve our goal of increasing knowledge of the three R's, reduce, recycle and reuse, all while protecting our environment by trying to live a "greener" life.

The overall winner will have a banner created from their poster and it will be prominently displayed along Town Hall Drive during Morrisville Recycles Week and at other activities throughout the year. A certificate and letter from the Mayor will also be awarded for each 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner in each grade group along with their artwork being displayed at Town Hall. The eligible grade groups are Kindergarten, First Grade, Second Grade, Third Grade, Fourth Grade, and Fifth Grade.

Eligibility:

All children must be a resident of Morrisville or a student attending a school within Morrisville.

Poster Theme:

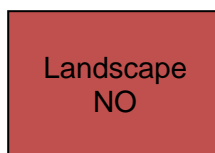
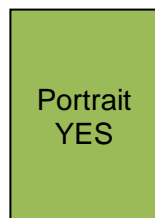
The Morrisville Recycles Poster Contest will have the following theme:

"Mean Green Recycling Machine"

Participants are encouraged to share their views on these themes.

Specific rules for Posters:

1. Posters created by students must be their own original artwork.
2. **Posters must be submitted on paper or poster board and may be no larger than 8.5" x 11" in size and layout must be portrait only. Landscape will not work on the banner.**



3. No copyrighted characters or magazine names may be used.
4. Any utensils except pencil are acceptable (crayon, marker, paint, ink. etc.).
5. Do not use plastic sticker letters.
6. Do not glue or tape objects on posters (often such objects are lost during handling).
7. Each student may only submit one entry.
8. Entry forms must be firmly affixed to the back of the posters and information should be facing out so that it can be read.
9. Entries must be received at Town Hall by 5 p.m., Friday, October 25, 2019.
10. **The Theme must be displayed somewhere on the poster.**
11. **We ask that there be minimal assistance from parents or teachers**

Morrisville Recycles & Environment Poster Contest Rules

Judging Procedure:

Posters must be submitted on paper or poster board and may be no larger than 8.5" x 11" in size and layout must be **portrait only! Landscape will not work on the banner.**

Each poster must have the entry form securely fastened to the back of the poster. Posters will be reviewed by the Morrisville Environment & Stormwater Committee and there will be one overall winner, as well as a first, second and third place winner selected from each grade level. (K-5)
