



## **STARTING A NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH IN MORRISVILLE CHECKLIST**

- Obtain a petition with 60% of resident's signatures.
- Recruit and compile block captains list.
- Contact Officer Barsotti, your Neighborhood Watch Coordinator at (919)463-1634.
- After a date has been agreed upon with the Neighborhood Watch Coordinator, find a location to conduct the start-up meeting. Local schools and clubhouses are good locations and are usually free of charge.
- Notify residents about the meeting, either by phone or flyer. Two notifications, one well in advance of the meeting and one two to three days before the meeting, are helpful in having a good attendance.
- Conduct the start-up meeting.
- Bring the petition to the start-up meeting.
- Bring the block captain list to the start-up meeting.
- Bring a list of all the streets within your Watch area to the start-up meeting.
- Complete this check list and bring it to the start-up meeting.
